Beneficiary Search

Overview

This allows clients to retrieve a list of active beneficiaries on the GoFundraise platform across different regions. You can use the query strings to filter the search results. If no query is provided the results will be ordered according to event rank if available.

This is a public endpoint

Method: GET

Paging

This endpoint is paged, with a maximum of 1000 results per page.

Parameters

query

- Search for beneficiary name

location

- Search for the beneficiary address string

region

- Search for results across regions - US, AU, NZ

eventcampaignid

- Search for beneficiaries associated to specified event campaign id

tags

- Search for beneficiaries that have specified public tags associated with them

Response

This endpoint's response will provide an ordered array based on rank unless using the location of query parameters, of which it will then be ordered by the query weight.

Event Beneficiaries (Deprecated)

Overview

It is not recommended to use this endpoint as it is not paged, ordered, or filtered, and can return a significant amount of data for larger open charity events. This is only to be used on with events with less than 5000 participating beneficiaries, and is in general, provided only for backward compatibility for grandfathered API users.

This endpoint does not return

- Beneficiary Tags, Themes, or External Id's

This endpoint requires Authorization via a Bearer Token
